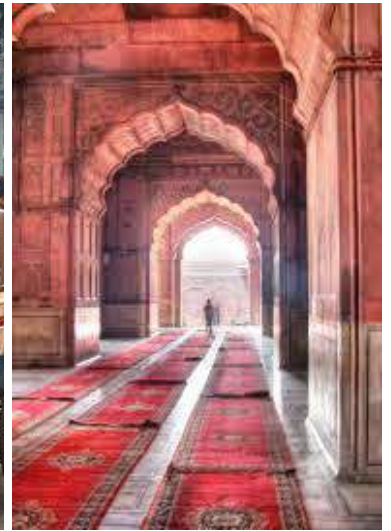
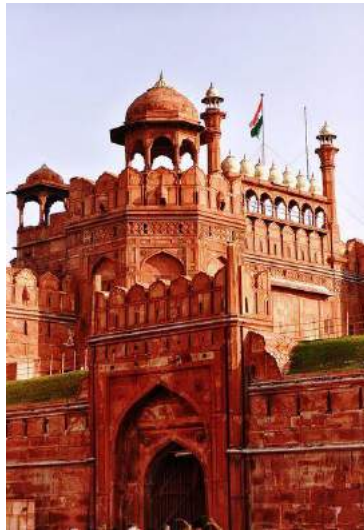

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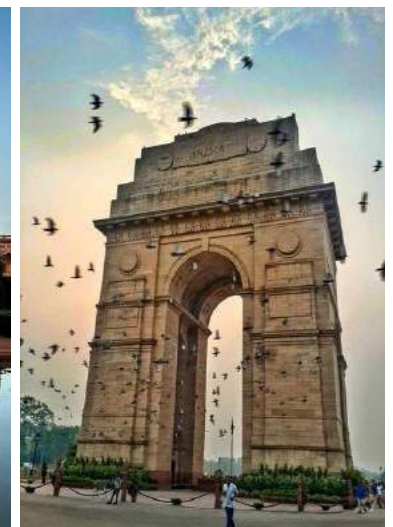
## *Amalgam of The Old & The New*

## Introduction

Agra is the city of the Taj Mahal, in the north Indian state of Uttar Pradesh, some 210 km from Delhi.

Agra's golden age was as the capital of the Mughal empire between 1526 and 1658, the city was founded much earlier. The earliest reference to Agra is in the ancient epic, the Mahabharata, while Ptolemy was the first person to call it by its modern name. The recorded history of Agra begins around the 11th century, and over the next 500 years, the city changed hands between various kings, both Hindu and Muslim.

In 1506, Sultan Sikandar Lodi, the ruler of the Delhi Sultanate, moved his capital from Delhi to Agra. His son Ibrahim Lodi was the last ruler of the Lodi dynasty, as he was defeated in 1526 by Babur, the first Mughal ruler, in the battle of Panipat. Agra fell too, and became the capital of the Mughals, whose rule over Agra was uninterrupted except for a brief period between 1540 and 1556. In 1540, Sher Shah Suri overthrew Humayun and became the ruler of much of Northern India, including Agra. After Sher Shah Suri's death, his descendants proved unequal to the task of ruling the kingdom. Hemu, a Hindu who served as one of Suri's generals, became the effective ruler. Hemu would later crown himself King Hemachandra Vikramaditya just as the kingdom was facing an assault from the reinvigorated Mughals. In 1556, Hemu was defeated and killed in the second battle of Panipat, and the Mughals took back the city of Agra.

Mughals were great builders. Babur built the Aram Bagh (Garden of Relaxation) which was modeled after the garden of paradise and was where he was buried after his death. His grandson Akbar refurbished the Agra fort and built Fatehpur Sikri, an entire city just on the outskirts of Agra.

He also renamed Agra after himself, and the city was known as Akbarabad while it was in Mughal hands. Akbar's grandson Shah Jehan would give Agra its most famous monument, the Taj Mahal, which he ordered constructed as a mausoleum for his most beloved wife, Mumtaz Mahal.

Day 01: Delhi / Agra / Delhi 204 Kms / 4 Hrs. (one way)

06h30 : Post your early breakfast (suggest carry packed cold breakfast) you will depart by Surface to Agra.

10h00 : Arrive Agra and proceed straight to Taj parking to board your battery bus to visit Taj Mahal.

10h15 : Enter inside the Taj Complex with your English Speaking Guide. Visit Taj Mahal.

**Taj Mahal**, built by Shah Jahan in 1560 in memory of his queen Mumtaz Mahal to enshrine her mortal remains. This architectural marvel is a perfectly proportioned masterpiece fashioned from white marble that stands testimony to the skill of 20,000 craftsmen brought together from Persia, Turkey, France and Italy and who took 17 years to complete this 'Love Poem in Marble'. **(Friday closed)**.

11h30 : Leave Taj Mahal Complex and gather outside the main gate to board your battery bus to visit Taj Khema.

12h00 : Arrive at Taj Khema for Brunch.

13h30 : Board your battery vans and leave to visit Marble craftman's shop.

15h00 : Leave by decorated autos (tuk-tuks) for fun ride till Agra Fort.

15h20 : Arrive at Agra Fort, disembark your autos for photo stop. Later board your buses for your return trip to Delhi.

Early morning in time pick up from your point of stay and transfer to Delhi railway station to board Shatabadi Express for Agra.

Meeting and assistance upon arrival and proceed straight to Taj parking to board your battery bus to visit Taj Mahal. Enter inside the Taj Complex with your English Speaking Guide. Visit The Taj Mahal.

**Taj Mahal**, built by Shah Jahan in 1560 in memory of his queen Mumtaz Mahal to enshrine her mortal remains. This architectural marvel is a perfectly proportioned masterpiece fashioned from white marble that stands testimony to the skill of 20,000 craftsmen brought together from Persia, Turkey, France and Italy and who took 17 years to complete this 'Love Poem in Marble'. **(Friday closed)**.

## GOLDEN TRIANGLE

**Tour Duration:** 3 Nights / 4 Days

**Day 01:** Delhi / Agra **by surface** **204 Kms / 4 Hrs.**

Early morning in time you will depart by Surface to Agra, upon arrival check in at hotel (check in 1400 Hrs.)

Agra is a city in northern India's Uttar Pradesh state. Its home to the iconic Taj Mahal, a mausoleum built for the Mughal ruler Shah Jahan's wife, Mumtaz Mahal (who died in childbirth in 1631). The imposing main building features a massive dome and intricately carved white marble inlaid with precious stones. This is set behind a reflecting pool inside a courtyard defined by 4 minarets.

Later in time visit the Agra Fort, containing the halls private and public audiences and other palaces. Shah Jahan spent years of confinement at the hands of his son Aurangzeb, looking wistfully at the Taj Mahal from the Fort.

Later proceed to Taj parking to board your battery bus to visit Taj Mahal till sunrise. **Taj Mahal**, built by Shah Jahan in 1653 in memory of his queen Mumtaz Mahal to enshrine her mortal remains. This architectural marvel is a perfectly proportioned masterpiece fashioned from white marble that stands testimony to the skill of 20,000 craftsmen brought together from Persia, Turkey, France and Italy and who took 17 years to complete this 'Love Poem in Marble'. **(Friday closed)**.

Overnight stay at the hotel - **ITC Mughal, Agra (Standard Room)**

**Day 02:** Agra / Jaipur **by surface** **254 Kms / 6 Hrs.**

Breakfast at the hotel

After breakfast depart by surface for Jaipur visiting Fatehpursikri enroute, the red sandstone Mughal palatial complex. Within the complex lies a mosque built by the Mughal Emperor Akbar and dedicated to Sheikh Salim Chisti, a Muslim Sufi Saint who blessed Emperor Akbar with a son.

Later continue drive to Jaipur, upon arrival transfer to hotel – **Hotel Fairmount Jaipur (Standard Room)**

It evokes the royal family that once ruled the region and that, in 1727, founded what is now called the Old City or “Pink City for its trademark building color. At the center of its stately street grid (notable in India) stands the opulent, colonnaded City Palace complex. With gardens, courtyards and museums, part of it is still a royal residence.

Overnight at hotel

**Day 03: In Jaipur**

The Amber Fort was used by the Rajputs for the dual purpose of defense and private residence. The fort encompasses charming gardens and magnificent palaces made from marble and precious stones, richly decorated with intricate stonemason works and paintings, which represented royal splendor and luxury of the Rajput era. To ascend up the fort, you may choose to walk, drive or take an elephant ride.

Afternoon visit the City Palace complex with its various museums where you can see a beautiful collection of Mughal costumes, weapons and miniature paintings. Then visit the fascinating Jantar Mantar, the ancient astronomical observatory built by the Maharaja of Jaipur, which is the largest stone observatory in the world. Also drive past Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds), a remarkable five storied building along the main street of the old city with semi-octagonal and delicate honey-combed sandstone windows.

Overnight at hotel - **Hotel Fairmount Jaipur (Standard Room)**

**Day 04: Jaipur / Delhi by flight AI-492 / 1330 – 1425 Hrs.**  
Breakfast at hotel

In time check out from hotel and transfer to Jaipur airport to board your flight for Delhi.
